

# Frequently Asked Questions about WildTeam's Training Workshops

### CHOOSING THE RIGHT WORKSHOP FOR YOU

**Is a WildTeam workshop suitable for me?** WildTeam training workshops are suitable for people with any level of education, in any subject. There are no prerequisites; all you need is a keen interest in the subject. We have people attend who are very experienced conservation practitioners, others are at the beginning of their careers, perhaps just completing or just completed an undergraduate degree in a conservation related subject, then others who are switching career from something completely different, for example, law, teaching or engineering. **Which subject should I choose?** This really depends on your previous experience, what interests you and if you are currently job searching, then what sort of job you want. ### FUNDING, DISCOUNTS AND PAYMENT

**Can I pay in instalments or reserve a place with a deposit?** We currently don't have the option to pay in instalments or pay a deposit. However, as long as there is plenty of time before the start of the workshop and the workshop is not reaching full capacity, we can hold a place for you for a few days whilst you arrange payment.

**How can I pay?** You can pay via PayPal, even if you don't have a PayPal account, simply by entering your card details online via our website. We also have the option to pay via Stripe which includes visa, Mastercard and other options. Alternatively, contact us and we can provide details for a bank transfer.

**Is it possible to receive an invoice or receipt for the training workshop?** Yes, if you get in touch we can send you an invoice and/or receipt. Please email [Lucy@wildteam.org.uk](mailto:Lucy@wildteam.org.uk).

**What discounts are available?** To support those who would like to attend a WildTeam training workshop but are unable to afford the full cost, we can offer some partial financial assistance via additional discounts towards the cost of a place on one of our workshops. **For online courses we offer £700 worth of free spaces.** A proportion of our bursary fund for each workshop is ring-fenced for individuals from countries where capacity and access to resources is limited, who are working on or studying important wildlife conservation issues. ## SIGN UP PROCESS

**What if I cannot see the “Sign up now” button on the WildTeam website?** This might be because you are using a browser that does not support the plug-in, for example, some versions on internet explorer. If this happens, please try accessing the page from a different browser, e.g. Google Chrome.

**When should I sign up?** Ideally, as soon as possible in case it books up as spaces are limited. As long as there are spaces left, you will be able to sign up until one week after the first live session. We recommend signing up at least one week before the first live session as that is when the first set of pre-recorded videos are sent out.

**What happens once I sign up to a training workshop?** You will get an email from us asking that you fill out a short form so we can get a few more details which helps us make everything run as smoothly as possible. Then closer to the workshop we shall send a detailed schedule along with other documents you need for the workshop. ## CERTIFICATION

**What certification will I receive?** Upon passing an exam at the end of the workshop **you will get a certificate** in that subject. The assessment is a multiple-choice exam with a 60% pass-mark. We go over all the material in detail, run revision sessions, and generally try to make sure you have all the support you need to sail through! Extra time can be given for those who need it.

**What if I fail the exams?** You can retake the exams at a later date for no extra fee. This is easy to arrange.

## WHO ELSE HAS TAKEN THE TRAINING?

## ONLINE WORKSHOPS

**What are the timings and structure of the online training workshops?** The workshops will run over 5 or 6 weeks (depending on the subject), with 1 live training session each week (with a choice of two options for times):

- 1) **One live session** with an instructor, lasting 1.5 hours. These sessions will involve interactive exercises to help you apply your learning, group activities and opportunities to interact with the instructor and fellow participants.
- 2) **A pre-recorded video** to watch at a time that suits you during the week. These contain teaching materials and short exercises. The length of these videos (including exercises) varies depending on the subject you choose, but usually are between around 1.5 - 2.5 hours. It is important that you watch each week's video before the live session, because there will be little time for recapping theory during the live sessions.

**Is any preparation required for an online training workshop before it begins?** A little, it will help you a lot if you watch the first pre-recorded videos which will be sent out six days before the first live session.

**What happens if I am unable to attend one of the live sessions?** We strongly encourage all participants to do their utmost to attend all live sessions, so that you get the most out of the workshop and are able to apply what you've learned. However, an absence will not prevent you from continuing with and completing the workshop. Live sessions are recorded, so you can catch up in your own time. No breakout rooms are recorded.

**What if the live sessions are scheduled for a time unsuitable for my time zone?** We would recommend only attending a workshop where live sessions are organised at an appropriate time for your time zone, to ensure you do not miss out on the taught content. However, we will run workshops at times to suit different geographic regions, and are always willing to consider running one at a time to fit with your time zone. Please email us if you would like to request certain timings for a training workshop and we will take this into consideration when planning the next one. If this is the case, we recommend you wait until the next training workshop is available because you will miss out on a lot if you can't attend the live sessions.

**Do I need to install new or expensive software to do an online training workshop?** The workshops use Zoom software. You will need to download this and make an account to log in. Zoom is free to download. You will also need working audio on your computer/headphones, a good internet connection, a microphone, and a camera (the latter two can be built into the computer). So nothing fancy. Nothing expensive.

**What happens if my internet disconnects during an online training workshop?** All sessions will be recorded, so if you get disconnected you can get a recording of the session or you are welcome to re-join the live session if your internet is working again.
